SENATOR RICK SCOTT'S LEGISLATIVE ACTION UPDATE

FIGHTING FOR FREEDOM & DEMOCRACY IN LATIN AMERICA

Securing Timely Opportunities for Payment and Maximizing Awards for Detaining Unlawful Regime Officials (STOP MADURO) Act: Senator Scott led Senators Ted Cruz and Bill Cassidy in reintroducing this bill to increase the maximum reward amount from \$15 million to \$100 million for information leading to the arrest and conviction of Nicolás Maduro. The reward would be paid out by the federal government using seized assets already being withheld from Maduro, officials of the Maduro regime and their co-conspirators, not taxpayer funds. Senator Scott applauds President Donald Trump for holding the illegitimate Maduro regime accountable and increasing the maximum reward amount from \$15 million to \$50 million on August 7, 2025.

Banning Operations and Leases with the Illegitimate Venezuelan Authoritarian Regime (BOLIVAR) Act: This bill holds Venezuelan dictator Nicolás Maduro accountable by prohibiting federal agencies from doing business with anyone that supports the oppressive Maduro regime. Denying Earnings to the Military Oligarchy in Cuba and Restricting Activities of the Cuban Intelligence Apparatus (DEMOCRACIA) Act: This bill holds the illegitimate communist Cuban regime accountable through severe sanctions and unprecedented financial pressure. This bill authorizes the president to immediately use all means possible to provide unrestricted, reliable internet service to the people of Cuba that is not censored or blocked by the Cuban regime. Venezuela Advancing Liberty, Opportunity, and Rights Act (VALOR Act): Senator Scott and his colleagues introduced a bill to help guide U.S. policy in support of a transition to democratic order in Venezuela.

<u>Sen. Rick Scott Leads Bipartisan Statement in Support of María Corina Machado</u>: In July 2025, Senator Rick Scott met with Venezuelan opposition leader, María Corina Machado, to receive an update on the fight for freedom and democracy in Venezuela. Following the meeting Senator Scott led a bipartisan statement reaffirming the United States' support María Corina and the fight for a new day of freedom and democracy in Venezuela.

<u>Sen. Rick Scott Resolution on 4 Anniversary of Cuba's 'Patria y Vida' Freedom Movement:</u>
Senators Rick Scott and Ashley Moody led a resolution commending the brave freedom-loving people of Cuba and condemning the illegitimate communist Cuban regime for their wrongful imprisonment, inhumane abuse, and persecution of Cubans standing for a new day of freedom and democracy.

<u>Sen. Rick Scott Letter to Secretary Marco Rubio</u>: Senators Rick Scott and Ashley Moody sent a letter to Secretary of State Marco Rubio applauding this administration's commitment to holding the Venezuelan regime accountable and urges Secretary Rubio to continue the administration's maximum pressure campaign on the regime.
