2 **TITLE VII—GENERAL**  
3 **PROVISIONS**

4 **SEC. 701. MONITORING AND REPORTING ON PERFORM-**  
5 **ANCE OF GRANTS.**

6 (a) REPORTING.—Each recipient of a grant under  
7 this Act, or an amendment made by this Act, shall submit  
8 to the agency awarding the grant a report that—

9 (1) describes, with respect to the project award-  
10 ed the grant—

1 (A) the cost of the project, including a de-  
2 scription of the Federal share and non-Federal  
3 share of the project costs;

4 (B) a projected return on investment for  
5 the Federal, State, and local taxpayer; and

6 (C) a timeline to complete the project; and

7 (2) includes an agreement entered into by the  
8 head of the applicable agency and the grant recipi-  
9 ent, under which the grant recipient agrees to return  
10 the grant amounts if a grant recipient does not meet  
11 certain performance metrics specified in the agree-  
12 ment.

13 (b) PLAN FOR RETURN OF CERTAIN GRANT  
14 AMOUNTS.—The head of the applicable agency shall de-  
15 velop a plan that requires that a recipient of a grant under  
16 this Act, or an amendment made by this Act, return to  
17 the agency all or any portion of the grant amount if the  
18 recipient does not meet predetermined performance  
19 metrics that have been agreed to by the grant recipient  
20 and the head of the applicable agency under an agreement  
21 entered into under subsection (a)(2), as determined based  
22 on the information provided in the applicable report sub-  
23 mitted under that subsection.
