1 SEC. 2. RULES NO LONGER IN EFFECT.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 801(a)(1) of title 5,
3 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
4 following:

5 "(D) For any rule submitted under subparagraph 6 (A), if the Federal agency promulgating the rule, in whole 7 or in part, revokes, suspends, replaces, amends, or other-8 wise makes the rule ineffective, or the rule is made ineffec-9 tive for any other reason, the Federal agency shall submit 10 to the Comptroller General a report containing—

11 "(i) the title of the rule;

12 "(ii) the Federal Register citation for the rule,13 if any;

14 "(iii) the date on which rule was submitted to15 the Comptroller General; and

"(iv) a description of the provisions of the rule
that are being revoked, suspended, replaced, amended, or otherwise made ineffective.".

(b) SUNSET.—Effective on the date that is 6 years
after the date of enactment of this Act, section 801(a)(1)
of title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking subparagraph (D), as added by subsection (a).
