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**A BILL**

To provide for greater transparency about China’s bilateral security agreements and joint police initiatives, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No CCP (Chinese  
5 Communist Police) in the United States Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY REGARDING CHINESE BILATERAL**  
2 **SECURITY AGREEMENTS AND JOINT POLICE**  
3 **INITIATIVES.**

4 (a) DEPARTMENT OF STATE PUBLICATION.—The  
5 Secretary of State, in coordination with the Director of  
6 the Federal Bureau of Investigation, shall publish on the  
7 Department of State website and any other travel alert  
8 system operated by the Department of State a list of all  
9 countries that have a bilateral security agreement or joint  
10 police initiative with the Government of the People’s Re-  
11 public of China or the Chinese Communist Party. The  
12 Secretary shall update the list not less frequently than  
13 every 6 months.

14 (b) FBI BRIEFING.—The Director of the Federal  
15 Bureau of Investigation shall provide an annual briefing  
16 to the appropriate congressional committees on the Peo-  
17 ple’s Republic of China’s widespread presence internation-  
18 ally through bilateral security agreements and joint police  
19 initiatives.

20 **SEC. 3. NOTIFICATION OF STATE AND LOCAL LAW EN-**  
21 **FORCEMENT, PUBLIC, AND CONGRESS RE-**  
22 **GARDING CHINESE POLICE STATIONS.**

23 If the Federal Bureau of Investigation discovers a po-  
24 lice station operated by the People’s Republic of China or  
25 the Chinese Communist Party within the United States,  
26 the Director of the Bureau shall—

1           (1) not later than 24 hours after the discovery,  
2           notify the applicable State and local law enforcement  
3           agencies;

4           (2) not later than 72 hours after the discovery,  
5           notify the public through a law enforcement bulletin;  
6           and

7           (3)(A) not later than 15 days after the dis-  
8           covery, provide a briefing to the appropriate congress-  
9           sional committees; and

10          (B) after the briefing under subparagraph (A),  
11          provide the appropriate congressional committees  
12          with a situational update not less frequently than  
13          once every 60 days.

14 **SEC. 4. APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-**  
15 **FINED.**

16          In this Act, the term “appropriate congressional com-  
17          mittees” means—

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19                 (A) the Committee on Homeland Security  
20                 and Governmental Affairs and the Committee  
21                 on the Judiciary of the Senate; and

22                 (B) the Committee on Homeland Security  
23                 and the Committee on the Judiciary of the  
24                 House of Representatives.
