SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF FOREIGN STUDENTS ENROLLED AT UNITED STATES UNIVER SITIES.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Each certificate issued to a uni-5 versity by the Director of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement under the Student and Exchange Visitor 6 7 Program shall limit the number of nonimmigrant students 8 described in subparagraphs (F) and (M) of section 9 101(a)(15) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8) 10 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)) who may enroll in the university to 11 10 percent of the student population of the university in 12 an academic year.

13 (b) WAIVER.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President or the Sec15 retary of Homeland Security may waive the 10 per16 cent cap under subsection (a) for national security
17 purposes or if such a waiver is in the interests of the
18 United States

(2) LIMITATION.—In the case of a waiver under
paragraph (1), a university certified to participate in
the Student and Exchange Visitor Program may enroll a number of nonimmigrant students described in
subparagraphs (F) and (M) of section 101(a)(15) of
the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
1101(a)(15)) that is not more than 15 percent of
